To celebrate 40 years of service in the south Orange County community, the Saddleback Valley Chapter of the National Charity League (NCL), Inc., hosted its annual Day of Giving and Clothing Drive. Donations were collected for 14 Orange County Organizations on March 19, 2025, at the Norman P. Murray Center in Mission Viejo.

“Day of Giving is one of the most meaningful events of our NCL year—a day when every class in our chapter comes together to support local organizations through direct donations of items. Each class is assigned and receives specific requests from the charities they support, and our members thoughtfully respond by collecting and delivering much-needed items—from household goods and hygiene items to comfort items, toys and seasonal gifts. ALEXANDER SHELLEY TAKES THE PODIUM TO LEAD PACIFIC SYMPHONY IN BEETHOVEN'S FIFTH AND THE EMPEROR PIANO CONCERTO

The four most famous notes in all of classical music—"dun dun dun DUN" from Beethoven's Fifth Symphony, and the composer's masterful Piano Concerto No. 5, nicknamed the "Emperor," are rediscovered through the lens of Pacific Symphony's next Artistic and Music Director, Alexander Shelley, as he takes the podium for three concerts, May 1-3. These performances set the stage for a deeper exploration of Beethoven's music and his 250-year legacy, planned for future seasons.

Shelley praises Beethoven's music for its revolutionary character and contemporary relevance, saying, "Beethoven's Fifth is like visiting the Sistine Chapel or reading Jane Austen or Shakespeare. It's breathtaking whenever you do it. That's why it's an icon of human culture, one of the great works of humanity. But it's also a great cultural pillar. It sustains different interpretations, and the differences are really varied, even within eras."

He continues, "The piece is about emancipation, about moving from dark to light. The first movement is the most famous, but the arrival, my favorite movement, is the finale with an ebullient C major. This is breaking the shackles of fate and darkness. He's showing you as a creative artist that we can all be enlightened, that we can find the light and joy at the end."

Inspired by Enlightenment ideals, Beethoven's music champions the human spirit and its quest for freedom. Within his final piano concerto, he explores the individual's right to be free with society's need to be governed through the structure of the one (piano soloist) versus the many (the orchestra). Nicknamed "Emperor" for reasons debated, but most likely for its regal quality, triumphal spirit, and warlike rhythms, it requires extreme virtuosity from the piano soloist.

Performing the role of the noble hero is George Li, a 29-year-old American pianist of Chinese descent, who has been praised by The New York Times for giving "A bracing, fearless account...Mr. Li's playing combined youthful abandon with utter command." He was a recipient of an Avery Fisher Career Grant in 2016 and silver medalist of the 2015 International Tchaikovsky Competition. Li has rapidly established a major international reputation and performs regularly with some of the world's leading orchestras and conductors.

The concert opens with Tan Dun's "Jubilation" movement from his symphony Heaven Earth Mankind, featuring the Southern California Children's Chorus led by Founding Director Lori Loftus. The work includes themes from Beethoven's "Ode to Joy" (Symphony No. 9) and was composed to celebrate Hong Kong's return to China. Tan Dun has emphasized that the piece is intended to unite people

through universal art and tradition, beyond politics.

The second half opens with Jeder Baum spricht ("Every Tree Speaks") by Iman Habibi, a contemporary commission honoring Beethoven's 250th birthday. Scored for the same instrumentation as Beethoven's Fifth Symphony, the piece reflects on environmental challenges and the urgent need for change.

As the composer describes, "Jeder Baum spricht is an unsettling rhapsodic reflection on the climate catastrophe, and is written in dialogue with Beethoven's 5th and 6th symphonies...Like much of Beethoven's music, this piece accompanies an unspecific narrative and imagery, and ends with a sense of resolve, one that I hope can drive our collective will towards immediate impactful change. Beethoven perceived nature as an image of the divine, if not divinity itself.

Taking place Thursday-Saturday, May 1-3 at 8 p.m. in the Renée and Henry Segerstrom Concert Hall, the concert

includes a preview talk with KUSC midday host Alan Chapman at 7 p.m. This concert is part of the 2024-2025 Classical Season and is sponsored by the Hal and Jeanette Segerstrom and Family Foundation. The 2024-25 season piano soloists are generously sponsored by The Michelle F. Rohé Fund. Tickets are \$30-\$160. How to donate blood
Simply download the American Red Cross Blood Donor App, visit RedCrossBlood.org, call 1-800-RED CROSS (1-800-733-2767) or enable the Blood Donor Skill on any Alexa Echo device to make an appointment or for more information. All blood types are needed to ensure a reliable supply for patients. A blood donor card or driver's license or two other forms of identification are required at check-in. Individuals who are 17 years of age in most states (16 with parental consent where allowed by state law), weigh at least 110 pounds and are in generally good health may be eligible to donate blood. High school students and other donors 18 years of age and younger also have to meet certain height and weight requirements.

Blood and platelet donors can save time at their next donation by using RapidPass® to complete their pre-donation reading and health history questionnaire online, on the day of their donation, before arriving at the blood drive. To get started, follow the instructions at RedCrossBlood.org/RapidPass or use the Blood Donor App. Amplify your impact - volunteer!

Another way to support the lifesaving mission of the Red Cross is to become a volunteer blood donor ambassador at Red Cross blood drives. Blood donor



ambassadors help greet, check in and thank blood donors to ensure they have a positive donation experience.

Volunteers can also serve as transportation specialists, playing a vital role in ensuring lifesaving blood products are delivered to nearby hospitals. For more information and to apply for either position, visit redcross.org/volunteertoday.

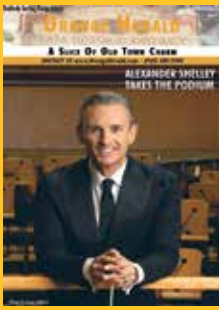

Use blender to grind up oats. Add soy milk, strawberries, banana, vanilla extract and sugar then blend until smooth. Pour and serve.

Taste of Wine & Food

MARISI LA JOLLA: A MASTERPIECE IN ITALIAN ELEGANCE

When Marisi La Jolla opened in 2022, it introduced a new level of Italian fine dining to La Jolla Village. The space exudes vintage coastal glamour with beautiful art deco flourishes throughout. Guests can choose to dine inside the stylish Lemon Room or at the marble bar, or enjoy the fresh ocean breeze on the patio or deck.

Executive Chef Cameron Ingle, who joined Marisi in August 2023, brings a wealth of experience from working with some of the most celebrated chefs in the country, including Thomas Keller at Bouchon Bistro, Ori Menashe at Bestia and Bavel, and Dan Barber at Blue Hill at Stone Barns. His reverence for old-world Italian technique, particularly the use of a wood-fired hearth, resonates in many dishes. "It's disciplined cooking," he explained. "It takes seven minutes to cook a piece of swordfish on the hearth versus two minutes on a cooktop." But as Frank and I discovered, the results are worth the wait.

Our server, Lucas Isumi, and Chef Ingle guided us through an extraordinary tasting—seven antipasti, two pastas, a main, dessert, and a curated lineup of wine pairings. This culinary journey revealed the kitchen's devotion to seasonality, thoughtful restraint, and perfect execution.

We began with focaccia, organic Tehachapi red fife flour baked to a lightly crisped on the outside and cloud-soft within round loaf. This was served with roasted green garlic dip along with whipped brown butter and aged balsamic. It was the perfect welcome bite, paired with Private Property Chardonnay, a creamy, fruit-forward white that lifted the richness of the bread and butter with its bright acidity melding with the acidity of the aged balsamic.

The next float in our culinary parade featured three beautifully plated antipasti. Local Crudo delivered pristine slices of raw local fish served with calamansi vinaigrette, shallots, and crispy caper creating a nice tang for the crudo. The Chicken Liver Mousse was silky and savory, paired with jujube

purée and large seasoned crackers for a satisfying contrast of textures. The Tomato Tartare, brightened with caper, roasted garlic, and basil aioli, and served with grilled sourdough was a great example of Marisi's Italian prowess.

The next trio of dishes came straight from the hearth. Grilled Beets, blistered and smoky, were cut into cubes and served with creamy smoked goat cheese, pistachio, and raspberry. The combination evolved into a pink hue perfect for each beet bite. Colossal Prawns were roasted over hot embers and served with salsa roja, charred just enough to add intensity while preserving their natural sweetness. The Hearth-Roasted Bone Marrow was melt-in-your-mouth magic, topped with breadcrumb, roasted garlic, and Calabrian chili that brought a delightful hint of spice.

These bold and nuanced flavors were enhanced by thoughtful wine selections curated by Sommelier Chris Plaia, who has led Marisi's extensive wine and cocktail program for the past 2.5 years. With these antipasti, we sampled a flight of Italian wines: the crisp Tre Monti Albana, the mineral-driven Picariello Greco di Tufo, and the earthy Calabretta Etna Rosso from Sicily. Each wine played beautifully against the hearth's smoky intensity and the antipasti's varied profiles.

We followed with two pasta dishes showcasing Marisi's commitment to handmade excellence. The Rigatoni stood out, tossed in a fresh pomodoro sauce with Calabrian chili for subtle heat, stracciatella cheese for creamy richness, and basil for balance. Each bite was soulful and satisfying. The Carbonara featured bucatini noodles tossed with Winfield Farms bacon, egg yolk, and black pepper. For a limited time, it also included freshly foraged morel mushrooms from Northern California, adding an earthy richness to the dish. It was rich and comforting, playing a complementary role to the standout rigatoni.

The main course, local halibut, was a crown jewel of the evening. Perfectly seared and flaky, it rested on a silky potato purée with chanterelle

mushrooms and a kiss of lemon juice. The La Colombera Colli Tortonesi, with gentle creaminess from malolactic fermentation, elevated the dish even further, accentuating the fusion of the halibut and mushrooms.

To end the evening, we were presented with the Gelato della Nonna Cake. Built upon a pine nut sponge, the layers included semifreddo, strawberry basil sorbet, and vanilla bean gelato, drizzled with a touch of syrup and served with a pour of Antica Torino Amaro della Sacra. A perfect finale that whispered of Italian summers and Nonna's kitchen.

The name "Marisi" is a word blending of owners Alex Adler, Eric Adler, Alan Adler, Moy Lombrozo, and Isidoro Lombrozo's grandparents: Marila and Isidoro. It's a name that evokes family, history, and care, qualities that shine in every detail, from service to wine curation to Chef Ingle's elegant dishes kissed by their Santa Maria hearth and

the extra time it takes to cook food in the hearth's embers.

For those seeking Italian excellence in La Jolla, Marisi is not just a destination, it's a celebration of craftsmanship, heart, and culinary joy. Marisi is open for dinner Sunday through Thursday from 5 to 9 p.m., and Friday and Saturday until 10 p.m. Brunch is served Saturday and Sunday from 11 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. For more information or reservations, visit marisilajolla.com.

GOLDEN HEARTS AND HEROES: 10 YEARS OF IMPACT WITH THE GOLD RUSH CURE FOUNDATION

As the sun set over Dove Canyon Country Club, the glow inside the ballroom was unmistakably golden. The Gold Rush Cure Foundation's 10th annual "Celebrating Childhood Cancer Heroes" Gala sparkled with elegance, compassion, and community. It was my first time attending one of their events, but certainly not my last.

Founded by Sandy and Gary Barker 16 years ago, the Gold Rush Cure Foundation began after they lost their son, Christian, to a rare leukemia in 2007. Working from their Laguna Niguel home, they launched what would become the Pot of Gold (POG) program - customized \$500 gift experiences for children battling cancer and their siblings.

Rachel Connor, a licensed clinical social worker from CHOC Children's Hospital, said, "We try to time the Pot of Gold around a particularly hard stretch of treatment. Seeing these kids light up when the Gold Rush arrives truly makes their whole day."

Today, Gold Rush Cure has delivered 1,485 POG experiences and is active in 156 children's hospitals nationwide, all powered by volunteers. As National Operations Director Marci Padgett shared, "It's not just about giving a child a gift - it's about giving them a moment of encouragement during one of the hardest battles of their lives. We want them to hear: You're doing a good job. We see you."

The gala, with nearly 200 guests, had a fundraising goal of \$150,000 to keep these moments going. "We are all volunteers," Marci said. "It's just people showing up for kids."

Cocktail hour brought guests together with wine, imported cheeses, and fruit, while a robust silent auction offered memorabilia, day trips, wellness services, and fun family items like a kid's wagon and In-N-Out gift cards.

Dinner featured Dove Canyon's signature offerings - stuffed chicken with goat cheese, salmon with dill beurre blanc, a carving station, seasonal vegetables, and New York cheesecake with strawberry drizzle.

The energy soared when auctioneer Zack Krone led the live auction, helping raise funds with luxury packages including a two-night stay at Pendry Newport Beach, a week in Los Cabos, a Palm Springs vacation, a Montage getaway, Magic Castle tickets, a custom Taber Company playhouse, and a whale-watching safari with Captain Dave.

Three extraordinary children were honored as this year's Childhood Cancer Heroes:

Fourteen-year-old Aaliyah, diagnosed with Stage 3 non-Hodgkin's lymphoma, showed strength with style - once dressing up both herself and her IV pole for Halloween while hospitalized. She dreams of becoming an oncology nurse at CHOC, where she's received treatment and inspiration.

Six-year-old Penny, joyful and kind despite multiple rounds of chemo and a medically induced coma, captured hearts with her love of Hello Kitty and her unstoppable spirit. Even after battling anxiety and isolation, she still spreads sunshine to everyone she meets.

And 13-year-old Zeke, diagnosed with Hypodiploid Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia, has endured rigorous treatment, including a stem cell transplant with his brother Noah as the donor. Through it all, he maintained positivity and resilience, and today, he's thriving back in school with a love for Legos and theme parks.

A highlight of the night was the presence of more past honoree families than ever before. Sandy recognized them from the stage, welcoming back names like Marci Padgett; Noah and his parents Heather and Lewis; JoJo and her family Mark, Natasha and Giana; Isaac and Melissa Murphy; Max with dad Luis, mom Liz and sister Keira, and brothers Loukas and Leo; Marla, Amelia and Lauren; and Olivia, Erika and Enzo along with special guest - Amber Wallace, who was in treatment in Seattle with Christian.

"We've never had so many past heroes in one room - it means everything to us," Sandy shared, visibly moved.

As the night drew to a close, Sandy announced a big change: "This is our 10th and final gala under this theme, but not our final gala. We're mixing it up next year, and we're excited for what's ahead." She dedicated the evening to all heroes - past, present, and especially Christian.

To Sandy and Gary Barker, thank you for turning pain into purpose. To Aaliyah, Penny, and Zeke - thank you for reminding us of what real courage looks like. And to the Gold Rush Cure Foundation - thank you for showing us how a little gold can light up even the darkest battles. Sign me up for another week newspaper ladies!"

The above story may not be exciting but is typical of advertisers who are shopping for advertising that is affordable but gives them something back for their money. Here's another:

As a Woman Who Owns A Small Business These Newspaper Directory Ads are a Great Value

"We women have to work harder to make a small business grow. Thanks to small, affordable ads in this newspaper I've got ads running every week. Every call helps my business grow. I give you an A+ for good prices and steady results."

Looking for the Penny Saver in all the Wrong Places

"I Used to get pretty good results from the Penny Saver, but when the Penny Saver closed up, I found this newspaper's little directory ads are even cheaper and work just about as good. Usually get two or three calls a month and most of them wind up being my customers. My bookkeeper says your directory ads work pretty good for the money"

Newspaper Directory Ads Worked Just Fine, Cost Less than Half! Nice!

"We tried some slick magazine ads that had beautiful pictures on the cover and they worked real good for a while but they were costing us an arm and a leg so we tried these little directory ads in your newspaper.
